Check PowerSchool each week.

Turn work in when due. Late work receives a 25% reduction.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work (one day for make-up for each day absent).

Check MMS website for calendars and online homework postings.

Late Work PAST NUE

Late work is only accepted until the end of the unit in which it was due. It receives partial credit (-25% of points). No work after the unit ends is accepted.

Late projects receive a 10% penalty for each day late.



Citizenship and effort grades are earned quarterly based on student behavior and effort. Three tardies to class earn an N and four earn a U in citizenship.

Students begin the quarter with 100 points and this is updated daily in PowerSchool. Students must participate in class to earn an E (excellent).

Effort grades ranges from 5=Outstanding to 1=No effort evident.

Plagiarism & Cheating

Copying/cheating/plagiarizing on any assignment results in a 0%.

Copying classwork results in an "N" in citizenship and subsequent offenses, as well as cheating/plagiarizing on a quiz, test, or project results in a "U" in citizenship for that quarter.

All cheating is referred to Administration for further disciplinary action.

Absences

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work (one day for make-up for each day absent).

It work was assigned prior to your absence, it is due upon return to class.

Extra handouts are located in a file at the front of the room. It is you job to check the file box and get missed work

It is your responsibility to ask a classmate or me for help on making up any assignments. If you missed class notes, you must also get those from a classmate.

If you missed a quiz or test, it is your responsibility to schedule a make-up appointment with Mrs. Thompson.

Work is not generally not given in advance of absences.

Technology

If students bring a phone to class, it **must** be turned off and stored in the phone pockets.
